Groundworks and foundations are completed whilst your Care Capsule is being manufactured offsite. The project is then delivered faster than traditional construction.

What's in a Changing Places toilet?

All Changing Places toilets must provide adequate space to allow a user to be assisted by carers. A Changing Place should be a minimum 12m² (generally 3m by 4m).

There should be step-free access up to an entrance door that has a minimum clear opening width of 1m. Inside there must be a minimum ceiling height of 2.4m and enough room for a turning space of 2m x 1.8m.

In addition, the floor must be non-slip and there should be both good lighting and good room temperature control.

A Changing Places toilet makes day-to-day activities & outings accessible for everyone.

What are Changing Places toilets?

Changing Places is a government-supported vision which provides high specification changing and toileting areas for the disabled community.

A Changing Places toilet enables anyone, regardless of their disability, to go to the shops, attend hospital appointments, enjoy community life, socialise and travel.




